## Important Announcement

Dear School Owner:

The National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts & Sciences, Inc. (NACCAS) Board of Commissioners at its recent meeting held July 16, 2014, acting pursuant to Article XV of the NACCAS' *By-Laws*, voted to adopt certain amendments to the *By-Laws* previously circulated for public comment. Specifically, the Commission voted to amend Article III to:

- (1) Effective January 1, 2015, reduce the number of Commissioners representing schools who are elected by zones to five (5) and increase the number of Commissioners representing schools who are elected "at large" to two (2);
- (3) Effective January 1, 2015, provide that at least one (1) of the "at large" Commissioners representing schools must satisfy the ownership requirements of Article III, Section IV.A.4;
- (4) Effective January 1, 2015, provide that up to one (1) of the Commissioners representing professional services may be experienced administrator; and
- (2) Effective January 1, 2017, reduce the number of Commissioners representing schools who are elected by zones to four (4) and increase the number of Commissioners representing schools who are elected "at large" to three (3).

The Board of Commissioners has directed the Nominating Committee to take these changes into consideration in the 2014 Call for Nominations and election processes so that the elections will reflect the composition of the 2015 Commission.

**In order to fully implement these changes to the NACCAS *By-Laws*, the Commission is re-opening the Call for Nominations for all 2015 Commission vacancies (previously announced in NACCAS on June 17, 2014) for a period of two (2) weeks. In order to comply with the requirements concerning "at large" Commissioners representing schools, nominations for the newly-created second "at large" position shall be limited to nominees satisfying the ownership requirements of Article III, Section IV.A.4. (No nominations will be accepted for Zone 2 Commissioner, as that Zone will cease to exist on January 1, 2015.) Nominations will be accepted until August 20, 2014.**

Service on the Commission is both an honor and a reflection of a person's caring for the future of our industry and specifically, its educational sector. We strongly encourage you to submit the names of qualified individuals, perhaps your own, who would be willing to serve on the Commission. Currently this organization accredits approximately 1,500 institutions nationwide; the scope of its work is varied and interesting.
