Dear School Owners and Other Interested Parties:

The National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts & Sciences, Inc. (NACCAS) is sending you this reminder notice to inform you of a change in requirements regarding the submission of an Institutional Self-Study (ISS).

Effective, April 1, 2015, schools must submit their ISSs electronically to NACCAS. Schools can do so through the member login portal. There will be a \$250 processing fee assessed for schools who fail to submit their ISSs electronically. The \$250 processing fee for paper copy or CD-ROM submission is waived until April 1, 2016, (the first year). Any fees associated with late submissions will not be waived.
