NACCAS Accreditation Workshop – Frequently Asked Questions

1. When is the NACCAS Accreditation Workshop?

The workshop is held quarterly in March, June, September, and December.

- Saturday Pre-Candidate Class
- Sunday Standards and Policies
- Monday Concurrent Sessions and ICPE training with morning and afternoon classes
- 2. Anyone can attend, but who must attend?
 - A. Everyone must attend the Sunday and Monday sessions.
 - B. If you have never attended a workshop (the institution does NOT have a school reference number):
 - You must <u>also</u> attend the Saturday Pre-Candidate Class
 - One registrant must be an Owner.
 - You must attend within the 6 month period prior to submitting an Application for Candidate Status.
 - C. Candidate schools:
 - You are required to attend within 12 months after the Grant of Candidate Status; prior to submitting an Application for Initial Accreditation.
 - You are required to attend again if the Application for Initial Accreditation has not been submitted within the first 12 months of Candidate Status.
 - D. Accredited Schools (during the first three years of accreditation):
 - You are required to attend at least once during each of the institution's first 3 years of accreditation, after from the Grant of Initial Accreditation.
 - E. Accredited Schools (longer than three years of accreditation):
 - You are required to attend <u>between 9 and 24 months</u> prior to the institution's anniversary date.
 - F. NACCAS Evaluators:
 - You are required to attend within 24 months of attending a prior workshop.
 - New ICPEs are required to attend within 6 months of applying to serve as an ICPE.
- 3. To receive credit for attendance, when should I plan to arrive and depart?
 - The workshops are all day classes.
 - They begin between 8:30am and 9:00am.
 - They end between 5:00pm and 6:00pm.
 - Registrants must attend each day in full.
 - Registrants must sign the attendance sheets for all workshop sessions.
 - Plan to arrive the day before the workshop begins and leave the day after.
- 4. Is the registration fee for the school or individual?
 - The registration fee is for each individual.
 - Each individual must complete a registration form with Monday concurrent session preferences.
